**New Playground:** Our new playground will open on Tuesday next week (18<sup>th</sup> June). A huge thanks to school council for initiating this project to cater for the kids. I will be providing some initial guidelines for using the playground at next Monday's assembly. I hope all the children use our school values to ensure this area is respected. I will include some photos in the next newsletter.

**Pupil-Free Day last week:** Last Friday the staff participated in a full day of professional development with a focus on **Formative Assessment**. The day was facilitated by some of our leading teachers and everyone gained a great deal from the sessions that were presented. Formative assessment is about making observations of student progress and understanding **DURING** learning times as opposed to summative assessment which is usually done at the end of a unit of work. Learning goals for students need to be flexible as they develop deeper understandings and skills.

**What are we doing well?** At Banyule Primary School, the teachers understand that every child is different and they all learn at different rates. Teachers who support children's learning by staying 'tuned in' to every child's needs and progress are great teachers. You may not all know this, but we have confidential **electronic data walls** with student photos and we track the progress of your child by colour coding them for Numeracy, Reading and Writing. Your child's teacher is not the only one responsible for your child's progress. The '**Village**' approach is very powerful and the staff at Banyule PS do this well. Not only is the 'Grade Level Team' responsible for ensuring every student is experiencing success, so is the Leadership Team. Accountability goes up and down the line and everyone is responsible for ensuring your child's learning environment is a positive one. Thank you for **TRUSTING** us with your children. We are a school that is leading the way in many areas and this is just one example.

**Staff Biggest Morning Tea:** As you are aware, the community raised \$2,300 for The Cancer Council and the staff had another morning tea and raised a further \$800! That's a total of \$3,100. Well done everyone!

## CSEF (Camps, Sports & Excursions Fund)

The fund provides a payment of \$125 for eligible primary school students and \$225 for eligible secondary school students paid directly to the school, to be used towards camps, sports and excursion costs for the benefit of the student. Families holding a valid means-tested concession card are eligible to apply, as well as certain students and families who fall into a special consideration category.

Payments to schools commenced from March this year; however, schools can still accept and process applications for the CSEF until the end of Term 2, on Friday 28 June.
